A word from the coordinator

We welcome you to the last newsletter of the EnterSchoolMind project. This project aims to equip young pupils with skills related to the entrepreneurial mindset.

In order to achieve that, our first priority was to develop the entrepreneurial mindset of teachers equipping them with the appropriate tools in order

to cultivate the entrepreneurial mindset of their pupils. To serve this ambitious aim, we have gathered a team consisting of prominent colleagues from nine different organizations, representing five European countries. The majority of partners serve many years in the field of education and training,

while two primary schools provide the insight view of today's class reality.

All together we were working towards the creation of an European qualification for the entrepreneurial mindset of teachers in elementary schools that will be also certificated using ISO17024 (personal competences certification).

About the project

The project EnterSchoolMind addresses the development of the entrepreneurial mindset of pupils in primary schools in Cyprus, Greece, and Great Britain. By sharpening the teachers' understanding of today's importance of entrepreneurial skills and equipping them with supporting tools, they foster the pupils' skills related to the entrepreneurial mindset, which is seen as a competence which entails supporting society, taking over the responsibility for one's own life and starting initiatives that create value to society. The main objectives of the project were:

- To conduct research and identify the relevant competences in relation to entrepreneurial mindset of pupils and explore teacher training capacities in this field

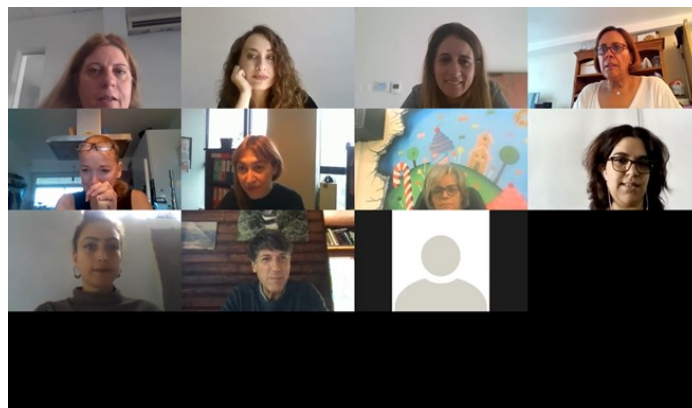


- To validate the teachers' entrepreneurial qualification with an ISO 17024 certificate and by doing that, strengthening the profile of their profession
- To develop the entrepreneurial mindset of pupils in primary schools by offering a toolkit with tailor-made activities, focusing on experiential activities
- To complete the picture, parents were involved through extracurricular activities in the last part of the project.

6th Transnational Meeting

The last meeting of EnterSchoolMind was held online via the Zoom platform on 7 October 2021. The meeting was attended by representatives from all countries of the project partners: Greece, Cyprus, United Kingdom, Italy and Austria. The meeting was opened by Mrs Christiana Knais on behalf of the coordinator, Mediterranean Management Centre, Cyprus.

During the meeting the partners dealt with the latest pending completion of the deliverables of the project as well as instructions were given for the organization of the multiplier events by the partners.



Multiplier events

Four multiplier events took place in October in the countries of the consortium, that is, Cyprus, Greece, UK and Austria. Each multiplier event lasted 3 to 4 hours and various stakeholders were invited to them: school headmasters (public and private), school teachers and other school staff, policy makers, private institutes, opinion leaders and parents. The aim of these events was to present the project's results, focusing on the teachers' training for the development of competences related to the entrepreneurial mindset and the corresponding ISO certified qualification, as well as the tools developed for the cultivation of the entrepreneurial mindset of pupils, including the electronic stories and the board game.

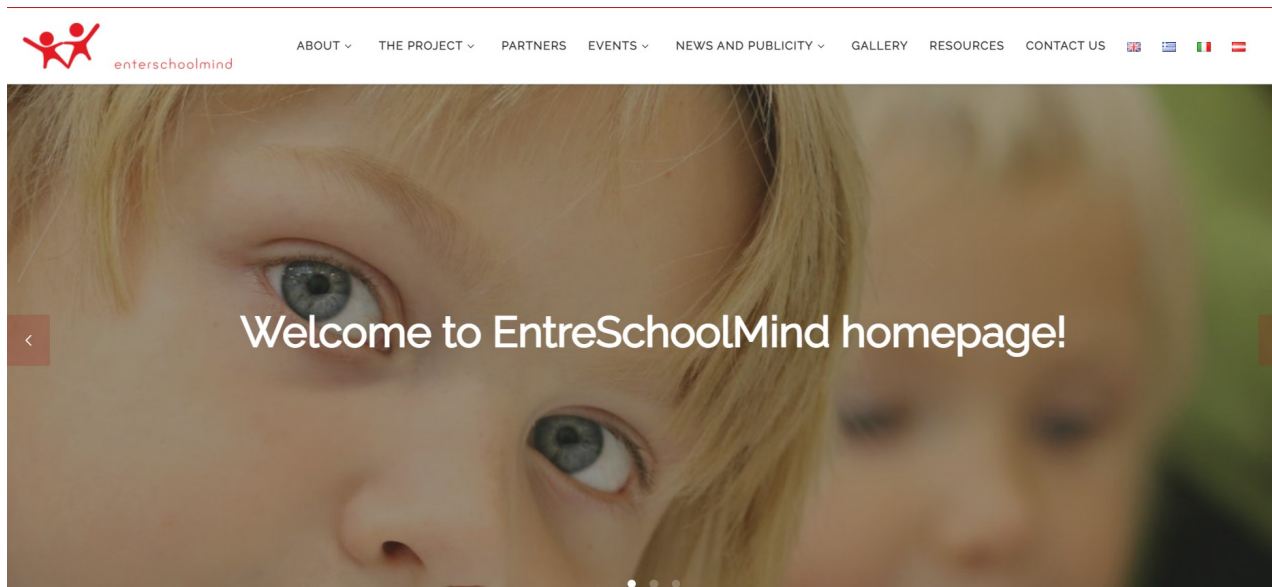


Project's Results Sustainability
