

Title of story: A Sunday Afternoon with Friends

Page 1

Summer holidays are still going on. It is Sunday afternoon and it seems to be starting to rain. Your parents are planning to visit grandma at the hospital this day. You convinced them to leave you at home together with Samy, the family dog. What are you planning to do?

- a) You are about to call your best friend Jana and invite her to come over to hang out and chitchat together throughout the entire afternoon.
- b) You are searching for the watercolors and brushes to start painting a picture for your mum's birthday.
- c) You can finally watch your favourite film without being bothered. And if there's still some time left, maybe a second one will come along.



It has started to rain. Raindrops are knocking on the window panes and creating a cosy atmosphere. Meanwhile your parents have left for the hospital and you are home alone with Samy. Exactly when you intended to call Jana, the phone rings. Jana is on the phone and asks if she and Fanny can come over. How do you respond?

- a) Great, I'm all alone and I was just about to call you. Let's kill time together. When are you going to be around?
- b) Definitely, I'm looking forward to it. We can watch a film together. Let me check which films would be suitable.
- c) Super, I am happy. I just wanted to start painting a picture for my mum's birthday, that we can work on then together.



Jana and Fanny expect to be here in about 30 minutes. In order to use this time efficiently, you sit down at the kitchen table and draw up a list of what you might be doing together. What are your plans:

- a) To watch the 3rd part of Harry Potter, which no one of you has seen yet.
- b) To create a collage instead of the picture for your mum, so that all three of you are able to contribute.
- c) To lie on the sofa and have fun playing games together on the tablet.



The doorbell rings. Jana & Fanny are finally there and remove their wet rubber boots in front of the door. Samy appears around the corner and runs barking and tail wagging towards Jana. The pottery vase on the anteroom box falls to the floor and one of the handles breaks. How do you react?

- a) You just give Samy a slap and send her to her basket and then remove the broken vase hoping that mum will not notice
- b) You pick up the pottery vase and put it back again, in a way that the broken handle cannot be seen at first sight
- c) You pick up the broken handle and get a super glue from the storage room and reattach the broken part.



After this moment of shock, all of you head to the living room and make yourselves comfortable on the sofa. While offering them coke and biscuits, you decide to jointly leave a message to your grandma in the hospital. How would it look like?

- a) SMS message: "all the best, dear grandma and get well soon;-) kisses and hugs from Jana, Fanny & Luise.
- b) Picture: you take a selfie from all of you and send it to grandma per WhatsApp with kisses & hugs from Jana, Fanny & Luise.
- c) Song: the three of you create new lyrics to granny's favourite song, give her a call and perform it aloud to her.



The rain has stopped for a while and the sun comes out. You change your plans and take advantage of this short timeslot and head out to the yard. Samy may join you. You propose the following to your friends:

- a) "Let's go to the big playground and swing with the largest seesaw".
- b) "Let's fetch the table tennis balls from the garage and play table tennis with the other kids in the yard".
- c) "Let's choose our favourite tunes, turn up the volume and dance until the music stops. When it does, we have to freeze in specific poses like animals, shapes, or letters, we may even have one leg up".



Due to the better weather conditions, you are not the only ones in the yard. The playground is crowded and the ping-pong tables are also occupied. Just as you are about to start playing your "poses" game, two kids appear before you, crying since they are obviously lost. They do not seem to be from Austria and do not understand your language. What will you do?

- a) You ask an elder boy nearby for some help, to finally get started with your poses game.
- b) Jana quickly fetches her mobile phone out of her jeans pocket and tries to activate the voice program. She uses Google Translator for English / German to try to get into a conversation with them and calm them down.
- c) You remember your family game evenings with pantomime tasks and try to communicate using your hands and feet to find out who they are and how you could help them.



A few minutes later, their parents arrive at the yard. They had been looking for them. Now you are finally ready to kick off. All of a sudden it starts to rain again slightly. You have lost interest in playing the game outside and decide to go back to the flat. Returning home, Samy immediately holes up and you come up with a great idea:

- a) You propose to heat up frozen pizza in the microwave and serve it with coke and then finally watch the film together before your parents return.
- b) You suggest searching for your favorite songs on YouTube, play them and sing along loudly.
- c) You recommend slipping into the role of mum, dad and children and re-enact typical scenes from your day-to-day family routine.



Time has gone by so quickly and your parents are already back again. By then it is already evening. Jana and Fanny are allowed to stay overnight. After dinner you put the sleeping bags on the balcony outside and you lie down together under the open summer sky, listening to the silence. What happens?

- a) The silence and darkness awaken your phantasy and you start telling them a narrative about friends walking in the forest and getting lost in the darkness.
- b) You take out your laptop and start to view some pictures from your last holiday in France, summer 2019.
- c) You all play with your mobiles until your eyes are shut out of tiredness.



The night came to an end far too quickly. The next morning you wake up very early. Your mum is first up and starts to arrange breakfast for all of you outside. To bridge the waiting time for breakfast, you finally put your ideas into action:

- a) You grab a box of cards and play your favourite card game called Mau-Mau together with Jana & Fanny.
- b) You're fresh out of ideas for things to do but you are still tired, thus you just listen to your favourite song on your headphones.
- c) Jana & Fanny continue playing with their mobiles and sending messages to their siblings and parents.
