



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Title of the story: Learning a new language

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It is September, the second week of school after the summer holidays. Although you had spent most of your summer at home, you had a great time! The best part was when your cousin Pablo came from Spain and stayed with you for three weeks. Pablo is really fun and you like him a lot, even though at the beginning you had some trouble communicating with him, because he knew only a few words in Greek. By the time he left though, he had learned many more Greek words and phrases and was even able to have short conversations in Greek. At the same time, he taught you some Spanish, which you like very much. In fact, you really want to be able to communicate with Pablo the next time you meet him. You would gladly enroll in a Spanish course, but you cannot, since all your afternoons are full. What will you do instead?

- a) You will ask your dad who speaks some Spanish to teach you at least some words and phrases.
- b) You will ask your teacher at school if she can recommend any online applications you could use on your tablet to learn Spanish.

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Your teacher recommends Duolingo, a language learning mobile application. You have already completed the first two levels of the mobile language app. You feel that you remember all the words you have learnt, but you still want to check if you really do. What will you do?

- a) You will write down the words in a list and you will give it to your mum in order that she can check if you can remember them.
- b) You will create a matching exercise with the words you have learnt like the ones your English teacher gives you at school.

You are pleased that your dad is helping you to learn Spanish, but you are wondering what else you can do. Your mum suggests that you listen to Spanish songs, so you find some songs on YouTube, but you are not sure what the best way to use them to improve your Spanish would be. What do you do?

- a) You search online to find the songs' lyrics and their translation in order to be able to understand what you are listening to.
- b) You just listen to them to familiarize yourself with the vocabulary and the pronunciation.

Your teacher tells you that there is a new pupil in your school who has just moved to your country from Spain. She knows that you are learning Spanish, so she says that it would be good idea if she introduced you to the new pupil. What do you reply?

- a) You say that you are not ready to meet the new pupil yet, as you have not learnt much yet. However, you will do so when you feel more confident about your language knowledge.
